Dear Parents and Carers,

Over the past couple of weeks, school has been incredibly busy, with so many wonderful opportunities for our children to learn, grow and shine.

On Monday 15th June, I had the pleasure of accompanying a group of Key Stage 2 children, with representatives from each class, to an athletics competition at one of our MAT schools, St Nicholas in Alcester. The children were fantastic ambassadors for Tanworth, demonstrating our Christian values throughout the morning through their encouragement, determination and excellent sportsmanship. I am delighted to share that our Year 3/4 team achieved an impressive 4th place, whilst our Year 5/6 team were just pipped to the top spot, finishing in an excellent 2nd place. It was a real pleasure to spend the morning with the children and I was incredibly proud of how they represented our school. Well done to everyone who took part.

Unfortunately, the tennis competition we had planned at Henley had to be cancelled due to the poor weather and, sadly, it was not possible to rearrange it before the end of term. We are hopeful that a new date will be arranged in the autumn. In the meantime, I am pleased to share that all children in Years 2 to 5 will be visiting Tanworth Tennis Club on 8th July for a tennis enrichment session, providing another fantastic sporting opportunity. Look out for details.

On Tuesday 16th June, we welcomed Adam Walsh, CEO of our Multi-Academy Trust, alongside Tim Nelson, Educational Consultant, for a Teaching and Learning Review. During the visit they met with leaders, visited classrooms, spoke with children and staff, and looked carefully at pupils' work in books.

We were absolutely delighted with the outcome of the review. The external reviewers found our pupils to be happy, confident learners who feel safe, valued and exceptionally well supported. They recognised the strong relationships that exist across our school community, praised the expertise of our staff in meeting individual needs, and celebrated the rich range of opportunities available to our children, including Forest School and our Platinum OPAL play provision, which enable our pupils to flourish both academically and personally.

As with any review, there are always areas identified to help us become even better. Our next step is to further strengthen consistency in handwriting and presentation across all year groups. Whilst Adam and Tim noted that the majority of pupils already produce work of a good standard, we will continue to ensure that the highest expectations are consistently applied for every child from Reception through to Year 6.

On Thursday, Year 2 enjoyed their visit to Dudley Zoo and Castle. It was a wonderful opportunity to bring their learning to life and I know they had a fantastic day. Please do take a look at their report on page 3 of this newsletter.

Then last Friday, we were able to enjoy our long-awaited Sports Day and Rainbow Run. I hope everyone who attended enjoyed the day and experienced the wonderful sense of community that makes our school so special.

I know from some of the feedback I have received that, unfortunately, a few parents missed their child's race because we were running ahead of schedule. I would like to sincerely apologise for any disappointment this caused. The races progressed much more quickly than anticipated and, with the exceptionally warm weather, we simply could not ask children to remain sitting in the sun waiting for the approximate times originally shared. The safety and wellbeing of our children must always come first and, whilst I completely understand the disappointment, I hope you appreciate why this decision had to be made.

Thankfully, the Rainbow Run rounded off the day in such a positive and joyful way. My sincere thanks go to our PTA for organising such a fantastic event. Sponsorship money is still being collected, so we look forward to announcing the total raised very soon. The funds will be shared between school and the charity chosen by the Spencer family in memory of Anjlee.
