Dear Parents and Carers,

It has been another busy week in school, although Miss Evens tells me it has felt a little quieter without the Year 6 pupils, who have spent the week enjoying their residential visit to Conover Hall.

On Monday, Early Years consultant Rachel Wilkes joined us to work alongside staff in Nursery and Reception. The focus of the visit was on developing high-quality interactions within provision, ensuring that adults make the most of every opportunity to extend children's learning, language and thinking. This has provided valuable in-class professional development for staff and built on the training we completed earlier this term.

There have also been several exciting enrichment opportunities across the school this week. Year 2 enjoyed a Florence Nightingale workshop, bringing their history learning to life through practical activities and role play. The children developed their understanding of Florence Nightingale's impact on nursing and healthcare while exploring what life was like during the Victorian era.

Year 5 have had a particularly busy week. On Tuesday, they travelled to Henley High School to watch a production before taking part in a Greek-themed workshop on Wednesday. The children had the opportunity to handle artefacts, explore aspects of Ancient Greek life and deepen their understanding of this fascinating period in history through hands-on experiences. Meanwhile, Year 1 enjoyed their much-anticipated Castle Day on Thursday. The children fully immersed themselves in their learning about castles and produced some fantastic castle models. Miss Baird has shared that it was wonderful to see their creativity, imagination and historical knowledge come to life.

Today provided an opportunity for every child to shine during our annual Shine Day. Miss Evens has shared that there was an eclectic mix of talents on show, ranging from musical performances and gymnastics routines to magic tricks, dance acts and demonstrations of special hobbies and interests. It was wonderful to celebrate the many different talents and passions that make our school community so unique.

Amidst the busyness of the week, we have also been welcoming our newest families. We have enjoyed a number of play sessions for children who will be joining Reception in September, as well as hosting our New Parents' Meeting on Wednesday evening. It was lovely to return from the residential for the evening and have the opportunity to meet new parents, answer questions and share all that makes our school such a special place to learn and grow.

As we move towards the end of the academic year, I continue to be incredibly proud of the enthusiasm, resilience and achievements shown by our pupils. Thank you for your ongoing support and partnership with the school.

I could not end this week's newsletter without a special mention to our Year 6 pupils. It was a privilege to spend the week with them on residential and to see them outside the classroom still living out our Christian values, following our school rules, and demonstrating such resilience, determination and independence. Watching them challenge themselves, support one another and embrace every opportunity was a real source of pride.

Throughout the week, a number of JCA staff and staff from other schools took the time to approach us and comment on how polite, respectful and well-behaved our children were. Their conduct was exceptional and reflected the values we work so hard to nurture together as a school community. Year 6 are a credit not only to our school, but also to you as parents and carers. Thank you for your continued support in helping them grow into such thoughtful, responsible and confident young people. We are incredibly proud of each and every one of them.

A special thank you must also go to Miss Cutler, Mrs Hall and Mr Fidler, who gave up time with their own families to accompany the children on the residential. Visits like this would not be possible without the dedication and commitment of staff who go above and beyond to provide these memorable experiences for our pupils.
