HOME LEARNING

Topic- If you go down in the woods today

Suggestions for home learning based on our topic include:

- Interview your parents and grandparents to find out about the toys that they played with when they were your age.
- Create a timeline of toys from long ago to now.
- Create a poster all about you and your favourite toys.
- Design and make a new game or toy.
- Make your Christmas toy list early! Use catalogue cut-outs, pictures, drawings & labels.
- Start a family games night with your favourite board games. Take some photographs of the fun you have!
- Get cooking - could you make some bonfire biscuits, toffee apples or another sweet treat for bonfire night?
- Create a piece of bonfire or fire-themed art. How creative can you get?
- Can you find out where the Houses of Parliament and the Tower of London are? Can you label them on a map or make your own London map?
- Explain to your family who Guy Fawkes was. Write some sentences to describe what he did.
- Make your own stuffed Guy - a tradition on bonfire night.

Spirituality Go on an autumn walk and collect leaves of different colours, shapes and sizes. Think about how the season is changing and the beauty of nature.

REMEMBER

- Read regularly and enjoy a range of books. Record your reading in your diary
- Log onto your phonic bug account to play your spelling games and read your 'ebooks'.
- Practise your spellings (after October half term) and bring your spelling book into school on Mondays.

Please remember these are just suggestions and your child can choose a way to approach their home learning which interests them. The children can present their learning in any way that they choose i.e. leaflet, poster, model, painting, photographs, recorded in their home learning scrap book etc. If you require additional paper or materials please ask.

Try to complete at least one for each half term's topic. Remember they can think of their own ideas too!
