What does it look like?

Reception and Year 1 parents attend a phonics workshop to brush up on their phonics skills and terminology!

All teachers and teaching assistants receive phonic training led by phonics lead.

Reception phonics split into two ability groups for rapid progress and intervention

Children in EYFS and KS1 have a decodable phonic based book matched to the sounds taught in lessons and an allocated Phonic Bug Club eBook matched with our phonic scheme – Phonics Bug.

KS2 spelling lessons are fun; always including games.

Phonic assessments are carried out half termly and phonic screens termly to ensure gaps can be identified and closed quickly.

Phonics intervention groups are fluid and support a wide range of children across the year identified from our assessment and class teaching.

KS2 SNIP spelling scheme intervention for our less able children, helps to close the gap ensuring all children meet their individual potential.

Snappy spelling lessons taught three times a week in KS2 and handwriting practice includes weekly spellings.
