There are no limits!</p> <p>Our curriculum is delivered through high quality first teaching under thematic topics. Our themes also prepare our children's' academic, social and cultural capital making use of local links and the wider world. Children are taught discrete subjects so that they know what they are learning and the skills of being an historian, artist, geographer etc. while also developing skills that they can apply to any subject like; organisation, teamwork, resilience investigation and reflection.</p> <p>With the use of brainstorming, retrieval tasks and our POP (Proof of Progress) quizzes children have the chance to retrieve prior knowledge and remember previous learning, allowing them to make links between previous topics and concepts. This allows deeper understanding of our key concepts over time.</p> <p>We believe that everybody's learning journey is unique and listening carefully to pupil voice and our talented staff ensures our curriculum is flexible to take into account local or world events and personal interests while still upholding a continual progression of skills and knowledge.</p> <p>Our curriculum is led and managed by our subject leaders and implemented against our school values.</p>	<p>Our children love school!
