## Detailed Spending Breakdown

### CPD – £5,564

Focus: External training for staff to improve subject knowledge and delivery confidence in PE and active playtimes

Result: Higher quality PE lessons; active playtimes; stronger progression; increased staff confidence at all levels.

### Internal Extra-Curricular Opportunities – £4,080

Focus: Range of clubs offered, including dance, football, multi-skills.

Result: Broader participation, especially from disadvantaged pupils.

### Equipment & Resources – £5,987

Focus: Active play equipment, indoor/outdoor PE gear, curriculum resources.

Result: More structured and engaging physical activity across the school day.

### Educational Platforms – £1,919.50

Focus: Digital resources to support planning, progression, and teacher CPD.

Result: Consistent high-quality PE teaching and easier assessment tracking.

### **Inter-school Competitions – £200**

Focus: Entry/travel to local events.

Result: Pupils gained valuable experience and improved sportsmanship and teamwork.

### **Looking Ahead to 2025–26**

- Continue CPD for new staff and expand confidence in specialist areas (e.g. dance, swimming).
- Broaden the range of inclusive clubs and ensure strong uptake from underrepresented groups.
- Embed PE platform resources into whole-school curriculum mapping.
- Strengthen links with School Games Organiser and local networks to increase competitive opportunities.
