



Are you thinking about becoming a Tany's Dell Governor?

Being a governor can be enjoyable, stimulating and rewarding and is a great way of 'giving something back' to the community. Everyone has something to offer and we want people from as many backgrounds and with as wide a range of interests as possible. Please don't be put off by thinking that you have to have specialist expertise or knowledge. Enthusiasm and interest is much more important to start with, and there is training and support available to help you throughout the four years term of office. And remember, you will be joining an established governing body and will be supported by fellow governors, with many years of combined experience.

Governors have three main roles:

- To support senior leaders to provide strategic direction for the school
- To act as a critical friend to the headteacher
- To ensure accountability, best practice and ultimately, work toward an outstanding provision

Governors also carry out a number of other important duties, which include:

- Ensuring Safeguarding protocols are compliant with national expectations
- Making sure school buildings are welcoming and safe
- Setting and monitoring the school's aims and policies
- Setting standards for pupils' behaviour and discipline
- Forming policy on the school's curriculum and collective worship
- Supporting the headteacher in determining how the school's budget is spent
- Hearing appeals and grievances
- Dismissal of staff

The Governing Body works together as a team:

- There are a maximum of seven Governing Body meetings each year
- Some Governors have specific responsibilities – for example, Special Educational Needs, Health & Safety, Child Protection, Curriculum etc...
- In addition to an induction programme, all Governors have the opportunity to undertake further training to build on existing skills or to help develop new ones




