<b>Human and Physical Geography</b> Understanding the differences that can occur within different areas of the world. Those that are naturally occurring and those that are man-made.	<b>Location</b> Studying places (topic related) and geographical features that exist there. Through their time at Tany's Dell, this will provide pupils with an understanding and insight into areas across the world.

<b>Mapping</b> Developing confidence when using maps and other geographical resources to study different parts of the world.	<b>Interpreting</b> Drawing conclusions about parts of the world, based on what they already know.

#### *In order for the children to achieve these we will ensure that:*

- *There is an effectively planned, geography curriculum, which ensures continuity and progression.*
- *Geographical knowledge is taught and built upon as topics are revisited across each key stage.*
- *Children are provided with a range of different opportunities termly to explore their understanding of the world around them.*
- *Children have opportunities to discuss and reason with their way of thinking.*
- *A wide range of resources are available, including atlases, electronic resources, fiction and non-fiction books, personal experiences and photographs, news and media, to generate curiosity and excitement around looking at the wider world and the subject of geography.*
- *The studying of people will help develop an overview of the world, and the lives of people around the world.*
- *We communicate, teach and encourage confidence in the children to use a bank of geographic terminology.*
- *At least one educational visit, within each Key Stage, will be linked to the class topic and promote geographical skills and knowledge.*
