**Year 12 German and History - Berlin Study Visit**

The History and German departments at Tipton are jointly offering an educational study visit to Berlin for our Year 12 A level students. The visit is 3 nights / 4 days and will take place in July 2023. This will provide students with the opportunity to further learn on one of the subjects and themes in A level History and German, deepen their understanding and exploring some of the themes in more detail.

To this end excursions are planned including, but not exclusively, to the following:

- Sachsenhausen Concentration Camp: former factory in Oranienburg used mainly for political prisoners during the Nazi era.
- Hohenzollernhaus: museum and memorial located in Berlin's north-eastern Lichtenberg district – State Prison in the Cold War years or the Stasi Headquarters Museum.
- Wannsee Conference House: venue for the conference in 1942 where the 'Final Solution' was discussed and planned.
- East Side Gallery and other remaining parts of the Berlin Wall.
- Mau Mau Men on the Tiergarten and other public art.
- Museum der Gegenwart – German Museum of contemporary art.
- Soviet war memorial in Treptower Park and other memorials.
- Topography of Terror: outdoor and indoor history museum in Berlin, located on the site of buildings which during the Nazi regime from 1933 to 1945 were the headquarters of the Gestapo and the SS, the principal instruments of repression during the Nazis.
- Berlin on foot: the Reichstag, Holocaust memorials, Berliner Dom, Bebelplatz, Alexanderplatz and other central public sites of interest to our students.

The visit will take place from **Thursday 13<sup>th</sup> - Sunday 16<sup>th</sup> July 2023**. All Y12 students studying either A level History and/or A Level German are eligible for the trip. Accommodation will be in shared rooms together in the Acama Youth Hostel, Tempelhofer Ufer 8-9, Berlin, 10963, Germany. Breakfast and evening meals are included in the price.

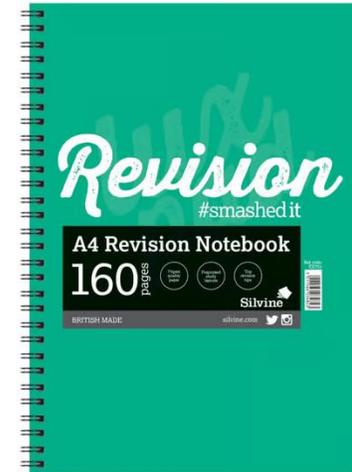
We have very clear school rules and expectations. Students need to demonstrate that they are following school rules and meeting our expectations in school in order for them to be allowed to attend the trip. If your child is involved in any significant behavioural issue in school this will result in them not being allowed to attend the trip. Money paid will be refunded. There will be no alcohol allowed on this visit.

The cost of the trip is set at **£995**. Please be aware that this cost includes a contingency cost of £50 that the tour operators have included in the price, due to the current economic uncertainty. If we can reimburse any of this money, we will of course, do so. We endeavour to make all trips accessible to all students who are eligible.

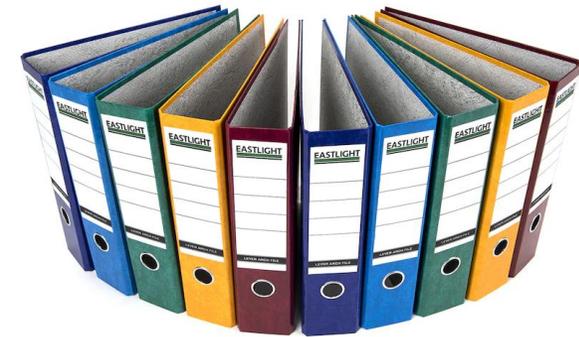
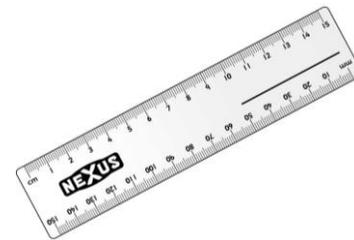
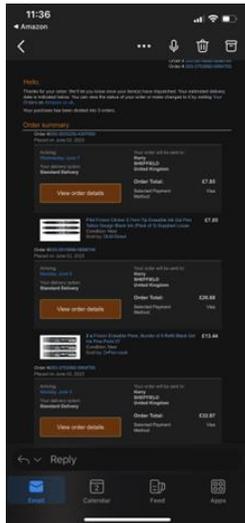

# Tapton 16-19 Bursary Eligibility

---

To apply for the 16-19 Bursary you must be attending Tapton School Sixth Form full time.

You can either be on or have received Free School Meals during your time in secondary education.

Your household income (parental/carer income) should not exceed £20,000 per annum.

We encourage any student to apply for the 16-19 Bursary as all applications are assessed by a member of staff and on an individual basis.

# Bursary Fraud

---

Committing bursary fraud is a serious offence.

Fraud is the act of taking money from someone or somewhere through deceptive, misleading or other illegal practices.

As per the Education and Skills Funding Agency Guidance (ESFA) 16 to 19 Bursary Fund Guide 2023-2024, it is the responsibility of the school to investigate 'instances of fraud relating to bursary fund applications', furthermore, it is also the responsibility of the school to report instances of 'significant fraud' to ESFA for further investigation.

Where students in receipt of 16-19 Bursary make fraudulent claims, for instance, by making claims and/or submitting duplicate receipts and/or receipts not relating to themselves and/or their academic activities, they will receive a **two-day suspension** and will be required to pay back any monies owed.

They may also have future bursary payments withheld.

Where the fraud is considered 'significant' they will be referred to the ESFA.

In addition, as per the School Behaviour Policy, the suspension will lead to the withdrawal of any Post-18 reference, including UCAS, that may be pending. Furthermore, if the student is employed by the Trust as a Lunchtime Supervisor, they will be suspended from the role for a four week period.

# 16-19 Bursary Request Types

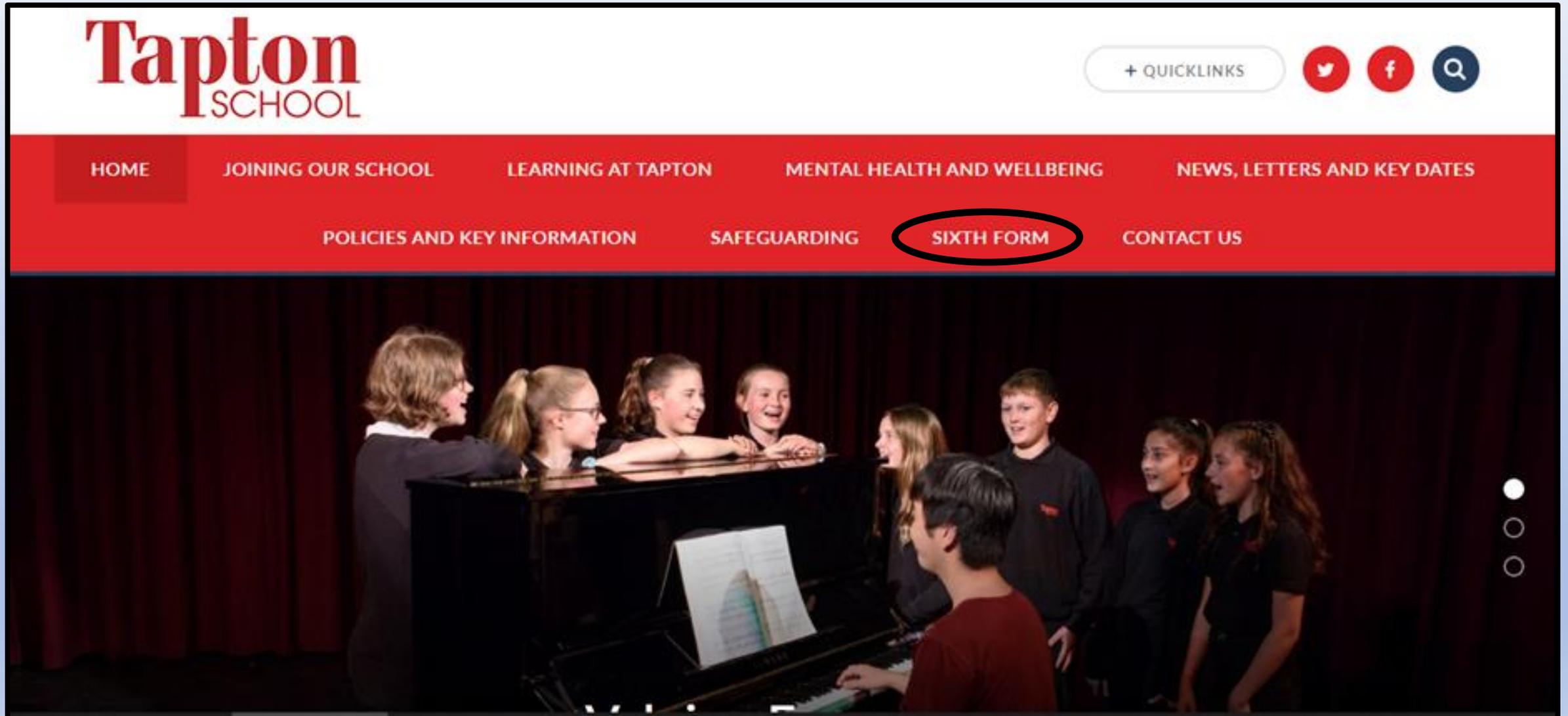

There are two ways that you can make requests using your bursary: Purchase and Reimbursement.

**A Purchase** is when you request the school to buy an item on your behalf. This can either be via Amazon or the school ordering system and can range from textbooks to basic school equipment.

**A Reimbursement** is when you have already bought something and would like to have the money refunded to you from your bursary allocation.

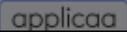
