Attendance

- We cannot authorise any holidays during term time.
- Full attendance at registration and all lessons is compulsory.

However, if you are unable to attend:

- Where a student has a planned absence, please e mail lridal@taptonschool.co.uk two days in advance.

If a student is unwell during the school day they must inform a member of Sixth Form staff and sign out in the Sixth Form office. We will call parents/carers to advise them that the student is leaving school.

Valid reasons for absence from school include:

- Medical appointments
- University Open Days
- University interviews
- Work experience placements
- Driving tests (students must not take driving lessons during the school day)
- Religious festivals
- Participation in a sporting or musical event
- Family commitment, funerals etc.

Where possible, students should arrange appointments outside of the school hours. Students should also avoid missing lots of lessons from the same subject. For example, attending a University Open day on three consecutive Wednesdays should be avoided.

It is not acceptable for students to be absent from school for any of the following reasons:

- Driving lessons
- Paid work
- Job interviews
- Holidays
- Eye Tests

Sixth Form students will be issued with an electronic ID card that they must bring to school each day. This enables the school to know when they are on site, and it will electronically update their attendance record.

We will send a text if your young person has not attended form in a morning and we have not had notification of an absence. Texts will also be sent at the end of the day for any unauthorised absences that have occurred.

16-19 Bursary

Free School Meals

Students can still receive Free School Meals whilst in Sixth Form. Similarly, if they become entitled during their time with us please let us know so that we can ensure this is received.

Important Apps that we use as a school

ClassCharts – this is for parents and students and allows us to keep you updated with letters, information and announcements. You will also be able to view your young person's attendance, behaviour and homework.

ParentPay – as a cashless school we use ParentPay to allow parents to pay for equipment, trips and to update their young person's meal balance.

Unifrog - an online resource for Post-18 Destinations available to all students.
