# **End of Academic Year Information Letter 2022/23**

I am delighted to be writing to you at the end of our first term in our new school building. It has been very busy year for Tarleton Academy, not least the move to our new build mid-year and the commencement of the demolition of our old buildings. As we have done previously, we have detailed our end of year highlights in a separate newsletter where you can find out all about our end of term activities as well as other events that have taken place this since the move.

#### **OFSTED**

As you know we have recently been visited by OFSTED who spent two days with us looking at what we do well and how we can continue to improve. During the inspection, Inspectors met with teaching staff, curriculum leaders and our students. They carried out lesson observations and met with Senior leaders and our Local Academy Council members as well as representatives from the Endeavour Learning Trust Board of Trustees. We are expecting the report to be published in September and look forward to sharing it with you then.

As part of our move, we feel it is time to review the names of our Houses. We have consulted with the students and staff and wanted new house names that honoured the legacy of the original school. We feel that the best way to do this is by renaming the Houses after the old school buildings, so from September the house names will be;

#### **Autumn Term**

Wednesday 6<sup>th</sup> September will be the first day in school for all students. Year 7 and 11 students are expected in school at 8.45am. Students in Years 8, 9 and 10 should arrive from 11am for an 11.20 tutor period. This later start allows us to induct our new Year 7 students, supported by our Year 11s, into their new school environment. Please note the buses will run as normal in the morning and afternoon, meaning students in Years 8, 9 and 10 will need to make their own way here.

### Uniform

At Tarleton Academy our uniform is important to us. So ahead of September, we would like to take this opportunity to remind you about the Uniform and Appearance Policy. We are very proud of the fact that our students wear their uniform with pride and attend school looking smart and ready to learn.

We would also appreciate your full support with regards to skirts, which should be strictly knee length, without exception. Please ensure that your child's skirt is of the correct length before they return to school in September. If you have any concerns about the length of skirt and the fit, we suggest you contact SWI/Monkhouse and/or make an appointment to see them.





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With regard to school shoes, as a reminder, these should be black and sturdy. Shoes should be traditional and look like school shoes – ballet style pumps, such as Vivienne Westwood that slip on, trainers and those that are nearly, but not quite trainers are not suitable. To support you in your choice of school shoes for September I have also attached a Standards of Footwear document.

Please do not spend money on shoes that you are unsure about, if in doubt, please check with us. Finally, we have had a number of enquiries regarding our uniform supplier. We can confirm that SWI/Monkhouse is our primary uniform supplier however we can confirm that local retailer, Premier Sports in Ormskirk will be able to supply uniform products and make up badges locally.
