Change of May Bank Holiday – Monday 4th May 2020 to Friday 8th May 2020

The government announced in June that next year's early May Bank Holiday will be moved from Monday 4th May to Friday 8th May to coincide with the 75th Anniversary of VE Day. The then Business Secretary Greg Clark announced that "It will ensure as many people as possible have the opportunity to remember and honour our heroes of the Second World War and reflect on the sacrifices of a generation."
