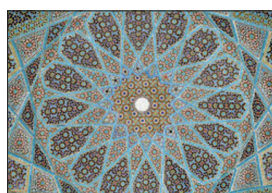

### WEBINAR 1 - CIVILIZATION

### WEBINAR 2 - EMPIRE

### WEBINAR 3 - MONARCHY

This practical webinar will show how to weave in consistent coverage of the term Monarchy across your curriculum map from KS1 and in to KS2, drawing on substantive knowledge such as that of comparisons between significant monarchs like Elizabeth the First and Second, pharaohs of Ancient Egypt, emperors of Rome, Anglo-Saxon and Viking kings, caliphs of Baghdad and British monarchs studied across time.
