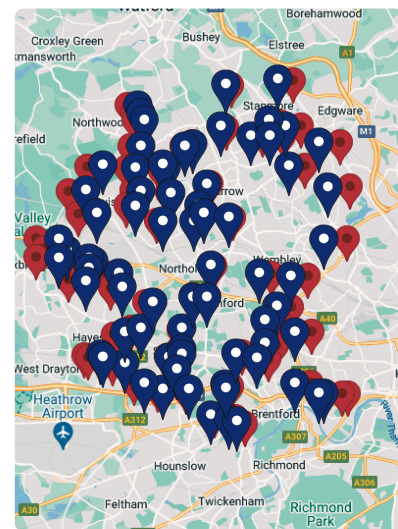

Explore our courses

Qualified Teacher Status (QTS)

It takes **one academic year to complete Teach West London's ITT course.** All Teach West London ITT courses begin in late August/early September and finish the following July.

QTS + Postgraduate Certificate in Education (PGCE)

Teach West London offers two course options:

Qualified Teacher Status (QTS) only: Qualifies you to teach in maintained primary, secondary and special schools in England.

QTS & Postgraduate Certificate in Education (PGCE): Qualifies you to teach in maintained primary, secondary and special schools in England **and** gain 60 Master's level credits.

Salaried

Non-Salaried (fee funded)

The course fees are:

- QTS only: £8,200 **or**
- QTS + PGCE: £9,250

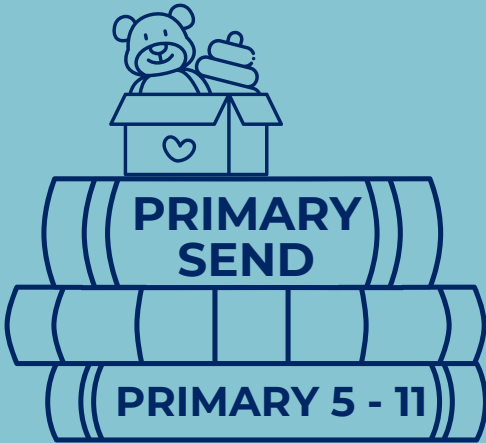
