This list covers a range of abilities and is an excellent way to prepare for secondary school.

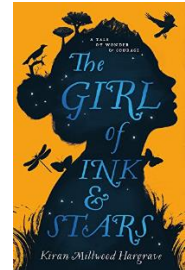
