A chance to have your voices heard

Spanning from Key Stage 1 through to Key Stage 5, the <u>Curriculum and Assessment Review</u> will look closely at the key challenges to attainment for young people, and the barriers which hold children back from the opportunities and life chances they deserve – in particular those who are socioeconomically disadvantaged, or with special educational needs or disabilities (SEND).

The review is seeking the views of:

- young people
- parents
- teachers and leaders
- education experts
- employers

on the strengths and weaknesses of the current system and how it can be improved.

Call for evidence: Deadline 22nd November 2024

The call for evidence invites stakeholders to submit proposals on improving the curriculum and assessment system. This is an opportunity to share:

- your ideas for potential improvements to the current curriculum and assessment system.
- what works well with the current systems
- details of anything that doesn't work

This call for evidence is crucial for the review process, with the gathered material aiding the panel in making its first recommendations next year.

Take part and share your views and insight, based on your own experiences, by filling in the survey.
