English	<p><u>Recount/diary</u> Choose one day when you are not at school. Write a diary entry. Use time words.</p>	<p><u>Poetry</u> Can you use book or the internet to find a poem about winter. See if you can learn this poem.</p>	<p><u>Mystery</u> Have you ever read any mystery stories? The author Enid Blyton has written lots of mystery stories – find out about the main events in one of her books.</p>	<p><u>Grammar</u> Can you write some sentences using the words and, or, but, so, if, because?</p>
Maths	<p><u>Multiplication</u> Practise counting in 3's. Can you write the calculations? See if you can do the same when counting in 4's. Draw an array to help you.</p>	<p><u>Time</u> Practise reading the time on a clock. Can you read – o'clock, quarter past, half past, quarter to?</p>	<p><u>Shape</u> See if you can name any 3D shapes around your home and write down what they are. It could be a pyramid, sphere, cuboid, cylinder or something else.</p>	<p><u>Division</u> Can you share these numbers into 2's, 5's or 10's? 24, 35, 30, 56, 75, 90. Use number facts you already know to help you.</p>
Topic	<p><u>Science</u> We have been learning about types of rock. Find rocks from different places. Can you scratch them with a coin? What happens when you put in under water?</p>	<p><u>RE</u> We have talked about Mary being a disciple as she said yes to God and show she believed. How else does Mary show she is a disciple? What other Bible stories help us to know this?</p>	<p><u>History</u> We have been learning about the Stone Age and how people lived. Can you make a stone-age house. Plans are available in class to help.</p>	<p><u>Geography</u> Draw a map of the United Kingdom and label the four countries. Put a mark to show the location of Preston.</p>
Working Together	<p>We have been learning about being a good citizen. How do people work together in your community to show good citizenship?</p>	<p>Work together with someone in your household. See if they can time how long it takes you to put on your shoes, eat your breakfast or another activity in seconds and minutes</p>	<p>Choose a craft that you have not tried before (drawing, knitting, playing an instrument) ask a member of your family to join you in learning this new craft. You can email photos of your creations into school to show the class</p>	<p>We have created a set of rules for keeping us safe online. Can you produce a set of house rules for your family (all must agree), or perhaps a schedule of jobs each family member is responsible for (cleaning bedrooms etc.)</p>
