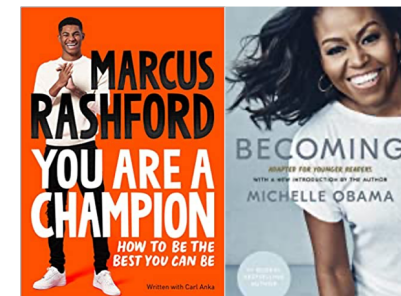

Reading Skills

- Demonstrate active reading strategies through book talk. Capture in reading journals.

- Scan for key information

- Distinguish between statements of fact and opinion within a text
