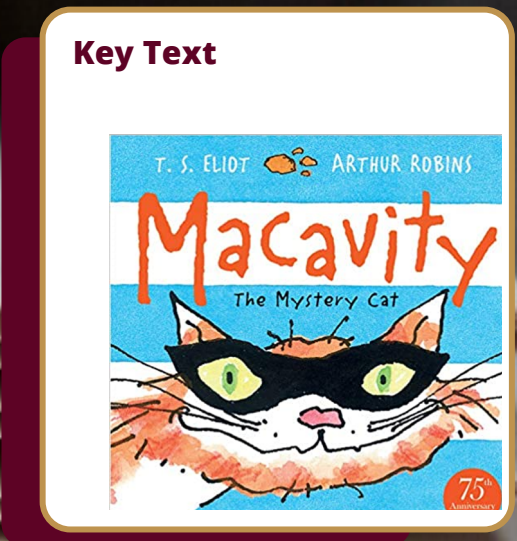




**Outcome**

**Reading Skills**

- Orally respond to texts, enthusiastically sharing their opinions. Capture some responses in writing
- Prepare a poem to perform to another class or assembly, showing understanding through intonation, tone, volume and action. Use text marking, colour coding and annotations to support planning and rehearsal.
- Identify, discuss and collect effective words and phrases which capture the reader's interest and imagination in poetry and narrative texts
- Work out the meaning of unfamiliar vocabulary using the context
- Use punctuation to determine intonation and expression when reading aloud to a range of audiences
- Justify responses to the text using the PE prompt. Teacher provides a piece of Evidence from the text for exploration and asks what Point is made. (Point + Evidence)
- Analyse and evaluate texts looking at language, structure and presentation and how these contribute to meaning
- Recognise and analyse different forms of poetry
- Participate in discussion about what is read to them and books they have read independently, taking turns and listening to what others say
- Develop and agree on rules for effective discussion, taking turns and listening to what others say
- Make extended contributions by making a point and elaborating

- Use commas after fronted adverbials
- Use inverted commas and other punctuation to indicate direct speech
