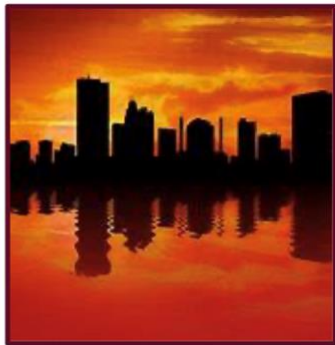

Printing Techniques



Block printing involves cutting out a pattern or making a pattern using string on a block of wood.

The pattern is dipped in ink or paint and pressed down onto the paper or fabric to create a print.



Mono printing is when you draw onto a clear piece of film or acetate and then using a roller you press down on the back of the film so that the pictures transfers on to the paper.

Aluminium foil printing is a form of engraving or etching. Using a pointed tool a pattern or image can be drawn into a piece of foil. Ink or paint can then be poured over the image settling into the design.
