Structure: An object made from several parts. **Aesthetics:** The appearance of an object. **Stability:** How firmly fixed a structure is. **Frame:** A structure that forms the base of an object. **Reinforce:** To strengthen or support an object. **Design:** A plan or drawing to show how an object will look before it is built. **Function:** The activity that is the natural purpose of an object. **Purpose:** The reason why something is built or exists.

Joining Techniques



PVA glue is a versatile, flexible glue that doesn't go yellow.



Hot glue gun is a good way to join materials and is much longer lasting than PVA.



Card corners can be used to strengthen a structure. Triangles are often used in construction as they help with stability.
