What each of the five characters were **feeling** at that time (Martine, Grandmother, Jemma, Mother Warthog).

Use the chart to help you to plan your paragraph before you write it. The first event has been put in for you, some of the things the characters are doing are not in the text you will need to make these up from your own ideas.
