Elephants

What do elephants look like?

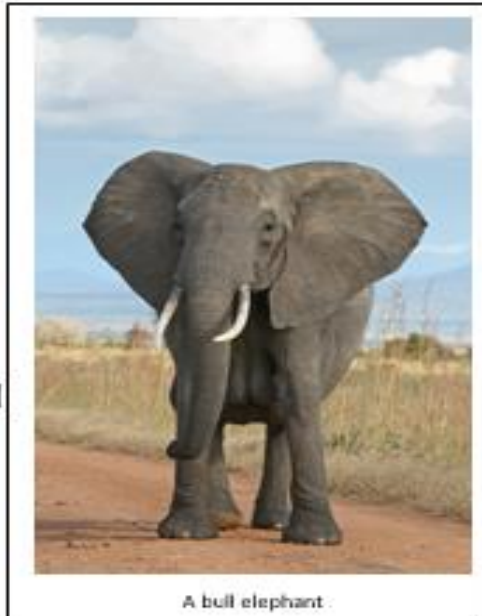

What do elephants eat?

Elephants are usually very gentle but can get quite cross. Elephants are very clever and know how to find water even when it is far away. When they find water they like to swim.
