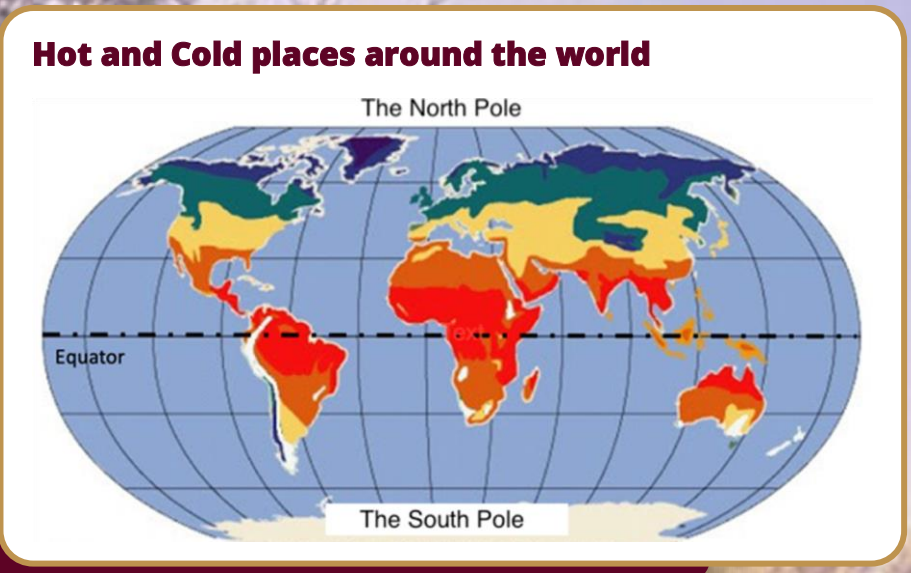

Antarctic: A polar region by the South Pole. **Arctic:** A polar region by the North Pole **Equator:** Imaginary circle that splits the Earth into two parts. North and South. **Atlas:** A book of maps.



Hot or Cold?

A place is usually hot when it is close to the Equator but can have a variety of different weather.

The North and South Poles are the two areas furthest away from the Equator. This means that The North and South Pole are the coldest places on Earth. If you go to a place nearby then it usually cold. Antarctica and The Arctic are extremely cold, with a lot of snow and ice covering them.

In the U.K. we have seasons that mean our weather and temperature changes depending on the time of year.
