Grid reference: A number given to a specific square on a map. **Eastings:** The horizontal direction for reading grid references. **Northings:** The vertical direction for reading grid references.


Grid references

Four figure grid references locate a gid square (usually 1km square) on a map.


The reference is given for the bottom left hand corner of the square.

The numbers are read Eastings first then Northings. You go along the corridor and up the stairs.

Map Symbols

OS Maps use symbols to show where features are on a map. The symbols show both human and physical features such as roads, rivers, paths, buildings and even public phones. There are lots of symbols so the map usually has a key to help you identify them.

Example OS Map Symbols

	Golf course or links
1 1	Information centre, all year / seasonal
*	Nature reserve
P PAR	Parking, Park and ride, all year / seasonal
X	Picnic site

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
