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<b>MUST</b>	<b>You must complete the 3 maths and 3 English lessons that are listed. If you have access to a laptop / tablet / phone, you will be able to see the slides online. If you need a paper copy, one will have been sent to you by your teacher.</b>		
	<b>Maths 1</b> LO: To complete number sequences and to add and subtract 10.	<b>Maths 2</b> LO: To add and subtract from a 3-digit number.	<b>Maths 3</b> LO: To practise and know times tables up to 10 x 10.
	<b>English 1</b> LO: To retrieve key information from a text.	<b>English 2</b> LO: To plan a non-fiction text using clear paragraphs.	<b>English 3</b> LO: To write a non-fiction text including key information organised into paragraphs.
<b>SHOULD</b>	<b>You should do the 3 additional subjects that are listed here. If you want, you can swap some for your brother / sister's 'should' activities and do them together. You can send photographs of your 'should' work to your teacher who will include some of them on the class blog.</b>		
	<b>R.E.</b> How can we show love to other people in our lives? Write about yourself – who did you show love/care to? Why did you need to show love/care? How did it help them? Describe/explain the situation and what happened Finish by writing a prayer asking Jesus to help us show love to other people.	<b>Science</b> Find an image of an invertebrate – JELLYFISH, SLUG, STARFISH, CRAB... Make a poster, draw it and label the main body parts. Explain the differences it has compared to a vertebrate – apart from spine! Other special features, what they eat, how they move, where they live...	<b>History</b> Go and look around where you live or look for some pictures on-line and find a house near you that you think is really old. Draw it/photograph it and write about what it is that makes you think it has been there for a long time. Next find a new home and compare them, what are the differences between them?
	<b>These are some regular activities that you could do more often as they will support your learning and help you to remember what we did together in school.</b>		
<b>COULD</b>	<b>Activity 1: Art</b> – Find a piece of artwork by LS Lowry that you really like, try copying it – use pencil. Next, produce a piece of your own artwork in the same style based on the place where you live – have plenty of people in it doing different things.	<b>Activity 2: PSHE</b> – Who is a good role model in our community? Doctor, Police Officer, Nurse, Priest... Draw this person and record around them the sorts of things they do to set us a good example. What can we learn from them?	
	<b>Activity 3: Multiplication recall</b> Write out your times tables, practice chanting them or log in to online program e.g. <b>"Times table Rock stars"</b> to practice your recall.	<b>Activity 4: Physical Activity</b> – 60 minutes a day Get outside and go for a walk or have a ride on your bike. Practise your throwing and catching skills outside – chest pass and bounce pass – how far can you throw the ball?
