Sweets/Snacks

- No sweets/snacks are permitted on this residential.
- We have lots of treats to give to the children at various parts of the trip.

Spending Money

- No spending money is needed on this residential.
- We have a very full 3 days planned and the children will not have time to go shopping.

Rooms

- The children have all written down 2-3 people they would like to share a room with. They have all been assigned at least 1 person they would like in their room.
- There will not be any downtime due to how busy we will be, therefore time in rooms will be minimal.
- Adult rooms are placed in between children's rooms and we will make all children aware of who their closest adult is, should they need them in the night.

Medication

Please could everyone fill in and return the medical form by <u>Monday 16th June</u> to allow all members of staff to become aware and familiarise themselves with procedures.

When dropping your child off on the Monday, medication will need to be signed in to Mrs Dieterman.

It must be clearly labelled with your child's name and instructions for administration.
