

## How many altogether?




Here we have 3 tens and 1 ten which is 4 tens.

$$30 + 10 = 40$$

Then we have three ones and four ones.

$$3 + 4 = 7$$

Altogether 40 + 7 = 47



Here we have 3 tens and 1 ten which is 4 tens.


$$30 + 10 = 40$$

Then we have four ones and five ones.


$$4 + 5 = 9$$


Altogether 40 + 9 = 49


Task 2: Complete and write the number sentences. You will need to count the total in each circle and add them all together. You can use the 100s square if you need.
