The standard units of time you need to use are;

Years, months, weeks, days, hours, minutes and seconds.

You also need to know the conversion equivalents;

- 1 year = 365 days (366 days in a leap year)
- 12 months = 1 year
- 31 days = January, March, May, July, August, October December;

30 days = April, June, September, November;

28 days [29 days in a leap year] February .

1 week = 7 days

1 day = 24 hours

1 hour = 60 minutes

1 minute = 60 seconds

Here is a poem to remind you how to remember the days in months..


30 days have September, April, June and November, All the rest have 31, Except February alone, Which has 28 days clear, And 29 in each leap year.

You also need to know how to represent the time in analogue and digital format.

Morning

CLOCKS

The alarm clock shows that the time is <u>quarter past eight</u> or eight fifteen. In the <u>morning</u> we say 8.15 <u>am</u>. <u>After midday</u> we say 8.15 <u>pm</u>.



On a digital clock, 24-hour times are often used. <u>8.15 am</u> is shown as <u>08:15</u>. <u>8.15 pm</u> is shown as <u>20:15</u>. To convert a pm time to the 24-hour clock <u>add 12 hours</u> (8 + 12 = 20).
