- Y2 PPA every other Friday (will usually be covered by Mrs Birch or Mrs Clarke)
- ▶ 2B Management time every other Tuesday
- PE day: Wednesday wear PE kit to school on this day
- Reading is so important in many areas of the curriculum and your help is invaluable Please listen to your child read daily and sign the reading diary so books can be changed regularly. Reading books will be changed on a Monday and a Thursday book bags to be sent in on these days only.
- Details regarding homework will be sent out next week please support your child with any activities which are sent home and encourage them to do their best.

Uniform

For the 2020 / 2021 Academic year, children will wear the new school uniform

- tartan skirt (black socks / tights)
- black trousers
- White shirt & school tie (All classes)
- school sweater / jumper / cardigan with logo
- Yellow gingham summer dress (optional, seasonal)
- Black shoes with either velcro, buckle or laces. (If your child comes to school in trainers, they will be asked to wear pumps whilst in the building.)
- School 'book bag' (children should not bring a backpack to school as we do not have appropriate storage)
- No jewellery of any kind must be worn to school.
- Long hair must be tied back and shaven patterned hair is not permitted.

PE is on **Wednesdays**. Children can wear their PE kit to school on these days.

KIT – If your child has not got their PE kit in school they will be provided with a spare.

- Plain black tracksuit bottoms for PE (no logos/stripes)
- burgundy or black shorts for PE
- white polo shirt for PE
- black school pumps/trainers for outdoors
- PE hoodie (optional)
- If your child needs an inhaler please ensure it is in school.
