

Our home learning is based on the topic **All about me**. You can upload it on to Tapestry or email it send it to your teacher.

You have to find it by being given clues. Hot means you are close to the object. Cold means you are not.	Physical Development Make an obstacle course in your home or garden. Time how long it takes to complete it.
