It has been an unprecedented start to 2021 with school not opening fully after Christmas. It has been hugely busy and an important term for the school.

The Resources Committee agreed to the purchasing of laptops to enable those families who required technology to enable remote learning. Staff, have been busy rolling out the remote learning plan, delivering laptops and guiding and helping parents with the various aspects of remote learning.

The Recruitment Panel have been busy since January selecting and interviewing for the new members of the restructured Senior Leadership Team and we are very excited for the future. An Assistant Headteacher, Miss Nichola Bonsor and a Deputy Headteacher, Mr Stuart Aris were appointed to join the team.

We have been working hard to ensure that we continue and effectively self-evaluate to keep moving forwards. Audits and constant monitoring of the teaching and learning has shown improvements.
