

# Tin can owls



Hi boys and girls I thought you might like to have a go and making these owls. You can hang them in the garden or use them as a container to hold your pens and pencils.

## You will need:

A tin can for the body any size (get an adult to check the edges are not sharp).

Bottle tops, jam jar lids or anything else you can find for the eyes.



I used a stone I found in my garden for a nose and string for the owls legs. You can use whatever you can find. Remember it's your owl.

Glue – don't worry if you don't have glue I made some using flour and water and it worked!!!

## Instructions

1. Choose the eyes for your owl and stick them on using glue or any other fastening you may have it's a little tricky. You may have to do them one at a time.
2. Next stick on the owl's nose.
3. Then attach your owls legs, you could give it wings too if you like.
4. Attach a handle if you are going to hang your owl up.
5. Finally if you can take a picture of your owl I would love to see them.
