Reading Skills

- When prompted through questioning, relates texts to own experiences
- Orally retell stories using props and pictures
- Develop and demonstrate their understanding of characters to role-play and drama
- Give opinions about books and stories
- Demonstrate understanding of texts by answering questions related to who, what, where and when
- Discuss the main events in stories
- Make predictions based on what has been read so far
- Identify the main characters in stories

Grammar Skills

- With adult prompting, separate words with spaces
- Use full stops to demarcate simple sentences
- Recognise and write capital letters from memory
- Use a capital letter for the personal pronoun 'I'
- Identify and use question marks
- Use the joining word 'and' to link words in sentences

Writing Skills

- Orally plan and sequence ideas in a narrative
- With adult support, re-read every sentence to check it makes sense
- Aurally compose and write sentences to form short narratives
- Discuss their writing with adults and peers, giving an opinion
