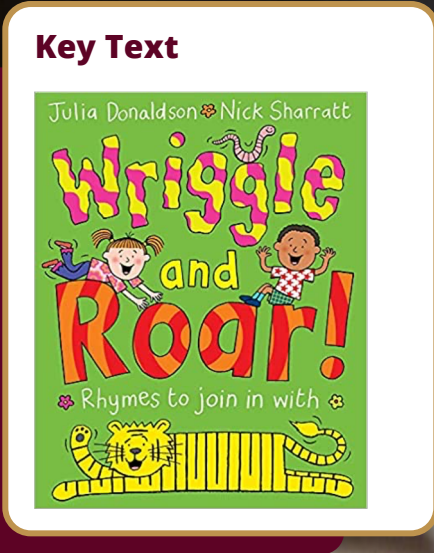

- Identify and use question marks and exclamation marks in independent writing
- Use the joining word 'and' to link words and clauses in independent writing
- Use the joining word 'or' to link words and clauses
