HRSE - CT2

We consider our relationship with god and how we can deepen this through prayer, our behaviour and ensuring that we follow the example of Jesus. We think about how we can help those around us.

Religious Education

We learn about the Disciples and what is means to be a disciple of Jesus. We consider how the Holy Spirit comes to us through the Sacraments of Baptism and Confirmation. We know that we are free to choose how we want to live our lives.

HRSE - CT3

We know that God created us and we think about how we can repay Him by being a good disciple and making good choices.

PSHE

We learn about money and how people make choices about what to spend their money on. We think about how money can be used to help others.

Prayer and Liturgy

We hear about the story of Pentecost and consider why this is important to the Church.

Outcomes

Vocabulary

RELATIONSHIP – A way in which two or more people behave and are involved with each other.

WORSHIP – To show respect to God and perform religious exercises in honour of Him.

BEHAVIOUR – The way someone conducts themselves.

DISCIPLE – A follower of Jesus.

BAPTISM – A Sacrament during which you become a member of the Church.

CONFIRMATION – A Sacrament during which we choose to belong to the Church.

CHOICE – An option or decision that we make.

CONTRIBUTION – Something given or offered to a particular cause.

MONEY – Cash or the value of cash used to buy goods or services.

NEED – Something that is required.

WANT – To wish for or desire something.

PENTECOST – The celebration of the day the Holy Spirit descended on the Apostles.

Learning Step 5

Understand that during Baptism and Confirmation we receive the Holy Spirit.

Learning Step 6

Understand that Confirmation occurs after Baptism and generally when we are older and are free to make our own choices.
