Maths	Geometry Look at the Geometry activities on the Nrich website. There are games and ideas to support using the correct mathematical words for 2D and 3D shapes. How many 2D and 3D shapes do you know? https://nrich.maths.org/9020	Counting in 10's Play a game where someone says a multiple of 10 and you have to count on in 10's up to 100. Find some objects (bottle tops, coins, buttons, counters, Lego) to make a repeating pattern.
