Recount of familiar event (walk in the local area).

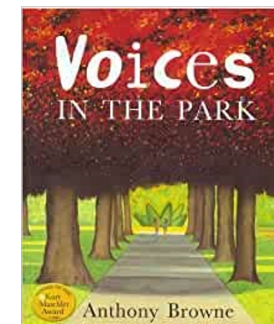
## Purpose

## Reading Skills

- Sequence the main events in stories using prompts, e.g. pictures, objects or questions. Discuss in a small group.
- Identify unfamiliar words within the context of a text and discuss meanings as a group.
- Recognise when a text does not make sense while reading.
- Demonstrate understanding of fiction and non-fiction texts by orally asking and answering who, what, where, when, why, how questions.

## Grammar Skills

- Say, write and punctuate simple and compound sentences using the joining words 'and' and 'but'
- Use sentences with different forms: questions and exclamations
- Secure the use of full stops, capital letters, exclamation marks and question marks
- Use subordination for time using 'when'
- Use subordination for reason using

- Discuss and plan what to write about
- Orally rehearse each sentence prior to writing including simple and compound sentences.
- Edit and improve own writing with specific guidance from the teacher
