at the Sydney Zoo.

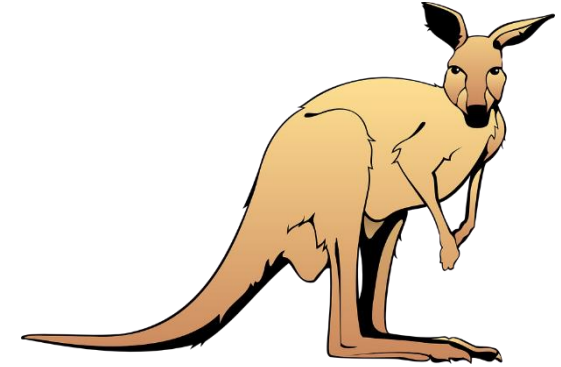
It turns out my Koala's
