English	Write a description about what you think life would be like on the moon. What would it smell like/ What would you see etc.	Find as many homophones as you can and list them.	Make a vocabulary map of all the words related to space that you can think of.
Maths	Practise weighing and measuring. Find something that weighs 1kg, 500g,10g and 5g	Play a game where you need to use a dice- snakes and ladders, frustration etc.	Practise telling the time. Make a clock out of a paper plate and practise making o'clock, half and quarter pasts and quarter to times.
Topic	Talk to someone at home about their memories of the moon landings (they will need to be over 50!)	Look on the school website for our school mission statement. What rules is this telling us to follow as a member of our school. Write a list.	Create a planet or the moon out of anything you can find.
