	Activity 4 – PE – Move like an animal! Choose 4 different types of animals (snakes, bears, lions, etc). Think about how they travel/move. What is similar? Different? Pick a starting point and an end point and try and travel as each of your animals. Which is the easiest/most tricky travel?	Activity 5 – DT – Using materials around your house (toilet rolls, cotton balls, etc) create your own model of an animal. Be as creative as you can.	Activity 6 - PSHE Take a moment to think about yourself and identify your 'spirit' animal. Draw a picture of you and the animal and write what things you have in common.

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
