**Sports Funding at The Blessed Sacrament Catholic  
Primary School**

The school has received a Sports Grant of £15,248 for 2017/18. In addition to this, we have carried over £1,446 from 2016 / 17, making a total of £16,694 available for spend. This money has been used to fund:

- Swimming provision for a third term (usually only a standard 2 terms) for both classes in Year 3 to increase provision to a term and a half each.
- Replenishment of all sports equipment for lunchtime provision and curriculum coverage.
- Support transport to matches and competitions for our school teams increasing participation in competitions for boys and girls football, netball, cricket and athletics.
- Improve sports participation across the school with the engagement of Preston North End coaches to inspire and motivate children and train and mentor staff.
- Improve engagement and opportunities in after school sports to all classes.
- Improve lunchtime sports provision through the use of a sports coach at lunchtimes and purchase of badminton and table tennis accessories to widen opportunities.
- Train Sports leaders to organise play and sports activities at breaks and lunches through mentoring by coaches in the Premier League Primary Stars Sports programme,

**Impact / outcomes**

- Staff are increasingly confident in delivering aspects of the PE curriculum due to observing a specialist deliver a series of sessions. mentoring, training and resources to help them teach PE and sport more effectively A specialist teacher is no longer required to deliver excellent provision in the areas of throwing, catching, striking and fielding for existing staff.
- Introduced new sports to encourage more pupils to take up sport and physical activities including table tennis, badminton and judo, involving the least active children.
- Increased swimming provision to 3 terms (usually only a standard 2 terms)
- More participation in events with the Preston Sports Partnership membership for competitions and festivals
- Engraving of sports trophies and awards to motivate and reward pupils.
