	<b>Maths 1 – <u>LO: Solve calculations using column addition.</u></b>	<b>Maths 2 – <u>LO: To solve calculations using column subtraction.</u></b>	<b>Maths 3 – <u>LO: To add and subtract using different methods.</u></b>	
	<b>English 1 – <u>L.O. To gather and interpret information from a text</u></b>	<b>English 2 – <u>L.O. To gather and organise ideas</u></b>	<b>English 3 – <u>L.O. To write a balanced argument</u></b>	
<b>SHOULD</b>	<b>You should do the 3 additional subjects that are listed here. If you want, you can swap some for your brother / sister's 'should' activities and do them together. Please send photographs of your 'should' work to your class teacher so we can put some on the Year 4 blog on the website.</b>			
	<b>Science</b> Several countries in Asia have a hot climate. Investigate which materials would be good for making a fan/parasol eg paper, card, plastic, fabric. How did you decide which material was best?	<b>Design Technology – Traditional foods</b> Over the next few weeks, create a cookery book that includes a traditional recipe and some information about its origins for each continent we study. This week we are looking at Asia. You could try following some of the recipes and take photos for your cookery book or you could draw pictures.	<b>Geography/Art</b> Research some countries that are in the continent of Asia. Look at their flag – can you create a country's flag using material in your house? How big can you make the flag? Be as creative as you can!	
<b>COULD</b>	<b>These are your regular activities that will support your learning and help you to remember what we did together in school. Try to complete these every day.</b>

Ask a grown up to challenge you on the times tables you know off by heart.	
	<b>Activity 4 PE - Stay active</b> Remember to aim for 60 mins of exercise each day (you can break it into smaller chunks of time) How many different ways can you find to exercise this week eg – take a walk, ride a bike, bounce on a trampoline, practice with a skipping rope, play football.	<b>Activity 5 RE (Celebrations)</b> The Catholic Church has a Saint's Feast Day for every day of the year. Find out the saint whose Feast day falls on (is the same as) your birthday. Then write a fact file for your Saint.
