Winter School Uniform September to March

- Black trousers or black skirt
- Green pinafore dress
- Green crested V neck jumper, crew neck jumper, cardigan or zipped fleece
- White formal shirt
- Green & silver school tie (optional in years 3-5 but compulsory in Y6)
- White polo t-shirt *crested optional
- Black or green tights
- Black socks
- Black shoes
- Leather/Patent shoes or plain black boots (no sparkles)

Summer School Uniform: April to July

- Green gingham checked dresses
- White polo shirt
*crested optional
- Black tailored shorts or trousers
- Black skirt
- White or green socks
- A formal sandal may be worn (no flip flops or sliders)
- Black leather shoes
- Appropriate sunhat

Please Note:

Our uniform does not include any item in Grey

Black trousers, shorts, Green pinafore or gingham dresses, white shirts, socks & tights at readily available at any major supermarket and NEXT or MATALAN

PE Kit: If weather is cool/warm, it is acceptable to wear winter or summer PE Kit

- White crested pure cotton round neck t-shirt
- Green unisex sports shorts or plain black shorts
- Green crested tracksuit bottoms or black sports leggings
- Green crested PE Hoodie *this is an optional item
- Daps or trainers (trainers can be any colour)

All PE kit should be brought to school in a suitable named PE bag which are available to purchase via our school uniform page

Crested Book Bags or Back Packs are optional, however, if your child is bringing a packed lunch every day, we recommend a backpack to carry all.

Additional Notes

Jewellery should be kept to a minimum. It is fine to wear jewellery due to a religious belief. Earrings should be small stud earrings. **Hoop earrings** are not allowed as they are a risk during PE lessons and at playtime.

Nail Varnish and Makeup are not permitted in school.

If, for cultural reasons, parents wish their child to wear a particular type of clothing during the school day, this is absolutely fine. Examples include turban, headscarf, or a PE kit that includes longer-length trousers.

Please ensure you label all your child's clothing and property with their full name, including water bottles and lunch boxes.

In the event of an item being lost, a clearly named item has a better chance of being returned to your child.

Any unnamed items, will be placed in the lost property boxes in the school reception and disposed of on a termly basis.
