

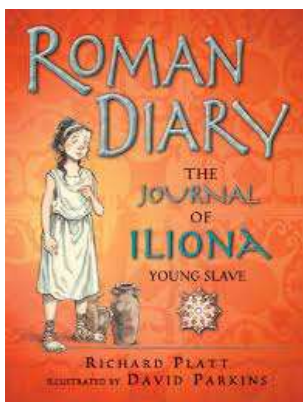


Year 3 Term 4 Newsletter

Welcome to Term 4

Welcome back! We hope you enjoyed the half term break!

In term 4, we will be focussing on our class text: Roman Diary.
The Journal of Iliona, a Young Slave



Within our writing this term, we shall be producing a range of different outcomes such as a letters, setting descriptions and a diary entry. In non-fiction, we will be producing a non-chronological report as our final outcome.

In Maths we will be exploring multiplication and division and learning written methods of these. To supplement this, we will be continuing to regularly practice our 3, 4 and 8 times tables alongside recapping year 2's learning of the 2, 5 and 10 times tables. We will also be covering money and teaching the children how to add amounts of money and also work out the change.

We will continue to link our learning to our texts where it is appropriate within the broader curriculum. Within our History lessons we will be studying the Roman occupation of Britain and how this has shaped parts of our country today.

We are excited about our visit to the Corinium Museum at the end of this term which will allow the children to immerse themselves in the Roman culture and engage in a workshop. Alongside this, we have our year 3 play planned which will all about the Romans. We can't wait to perform for you all.

In Computing, we will be learning about email and communication, teaching the children how to safely send and receive emails. In Art, we will be learning how to make mosaics and we will link this to our learning in our history, looking at real mosaics to inform our work. We will also have weekly recorders lessons, RE, PSHE and Spelling lessons.

Homework

Homework in Term 4 will be Spellings and either an English or a Maths task that will be linked to that week's learning. We also continue to ask for children to read at home 5 times per week. This will be sent home on a Friday and all homework books and reading books need to be brought back into school every Wednesday.

PE

PE in term 4 will be on a **Monday**. This term we will be learning how to play dodgeball. Children need to come to school in their PE kit on this day.
