## Welcome to Term 5!

We hope you and your children enjoyed the Easter break. We are looking forward to starting Term 5 and the learning opportunities that it will bring.



Our two texts that we will be focusing our teaching and learning around are 'The Pirate Cruncher' and 'Clean Up!'.

Within Maths this term we will be continuing our learning around the four operation; addition, subtraction, multiplication and division. We will look at embedding our knowledge of money by combining the notes and the coins together to make different amounts. We will also begin to calculate change. We will then be looking at statistics by interpreting tables and constructing different types of charts, including a tally chart and pictograms.

In Writing, we will be producing a leaflet and a character description. For both writing outcomes, we will be looking for the children to use the skills we have been learning throughout Year 2 in addition to our new skills.

PE will continue being every **Thursday**. Please ensure children are in PE kits on this day. Children with long hair need to have it tied back on this day.

In our Reading lessons, we will be building our skills and strategies to answer comprehension questions about what we have read. These questions will involve the children to use retrieval and inference skills. We will also continue looking at and finding synonyms of words from the text, as well as broadening our vocabulary, so that we can use them in our writing.

In Computing, our unit will be taken from the 'Computer Science' strand. In addition, we will have RE, Geography, Music and Personal Development lessons, all of which can be found on our coverage documents on the website.

Please continue to log reads into reading diaries and complete both the spelling and alternating English/Maths homework.
