On **Monday, 4th November**, we have arranged for a special workshop, "The Stone Age Experience," which will be conducted by the renowned team at Portals to the Past. - **Visual Timeline:** The workshop will conclude with a visual timeline, summarizing the day's activities and the historical periods covered.
