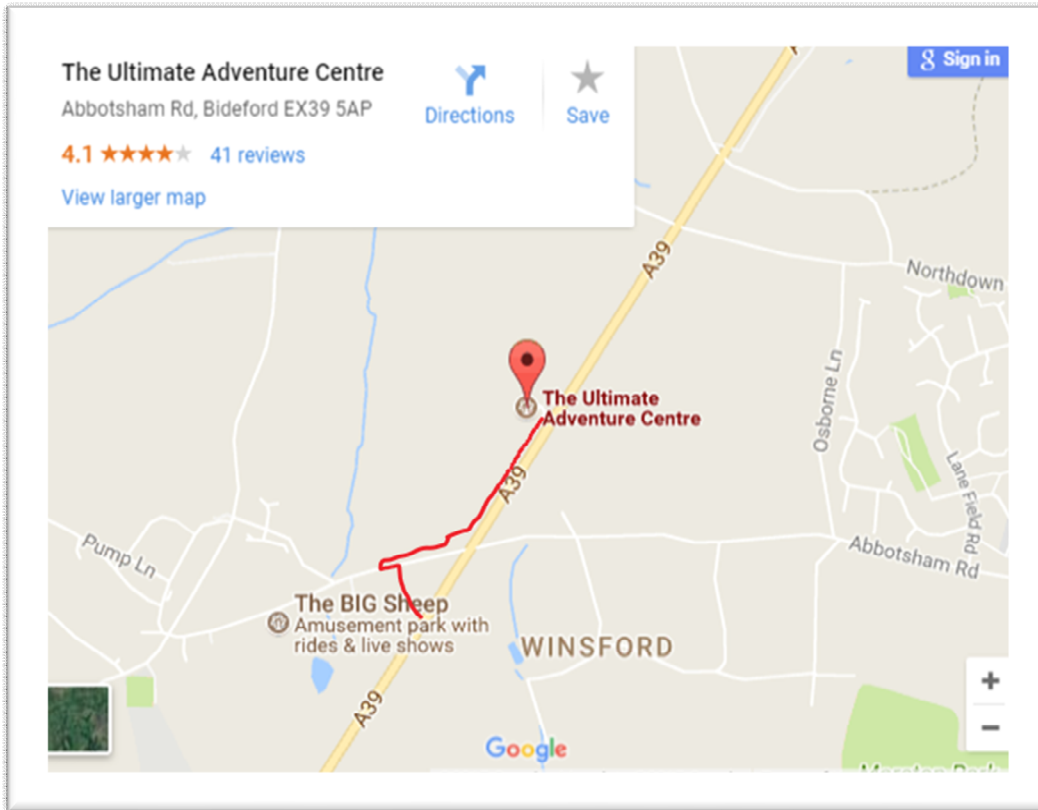




Year 6 Residential

Parent Information Meeting

Year 6 will be heading to the Kingswood Ultimate Adventure Centre, in Abbotsham, Bideford for their residential trip this year.

Timings

On Monday 17th June, we will leave school at approximately 9:30am with the aim to arrive between 12:30/1:00pm. Children to arrive at school at normal time on this day please.

Medication and/or money will need to be checked in with the adults at drop off. Please drop your child with their cases into chipmunks on this day.

We aim to leave the site at 12:30pm on Friday 21st June and should be back to school by 3:30/4:00pm for a later pick up time. Updates on timings will be sent on the day depending on traffic.

Activities

We will be completing a range of activities across the 5 action-packed days we are away, both during the day and in the evenings (we will send out a timetable once we have received it).

Children will be split into groups of 12/13 for the activities and they will remain in these groups for the week. Each group will be accompanied by a school adult and an instructor from the activity centre. The children will find out these activity groups in the weeks prior to leaving.

Accommodation

We have 51 children coming and children will be split across single-sex rooms. Teacher rooms are dispersed between these rooms. Children will find out their rooms in the weeks before we leave.

With the exception of Monday (where dinner will be provided) and Friday (where breakfast and a packed lunch will be provided), children will receive 3 meals a day.

Please could children bring a packed lunch on Monday as this is not provided. Everything should be disposable and packed in a disposable bags please.

Kit List

- Children must bring all of their belongings in a bag or case which they are able to carry / wheel independently.
- Children are allowed 1 case/bag and 1 small backpack for the coach journey.
- Bedding is provided however children are permitted to bring a pillow from home if they wish.

A full kit list will be provided alongside this presentation after the meeting.

What Not To Bring

- Electronic devices of any kind (**phones, tablets, apple watches gaming consoles etc...**) are not permitted on this trip.
- All medication must be signed in with an adult who will look after it for the entirety of the trip.
- Sweets/other snacks are permitted within reason but these must not contain nuts. If you choose to pack extra snacks, please be mindful of the quantity children are bringing.
 - No jewellery or valuables.
