New technologies are an essential part of children's and young people's lives, both in school and outside. The Internet and other digital technologies are powerful tools and open up new opportunities for everyone. They can stimulate discussion, promote creativity and encourage learning.

We believe that young people are always entitled to safe internet access so the Acceptable Use Policy for children and parents ensures:

- that young people will be responsible users and stay safe while using the internet and other communications technologies for educational, personal and recreational use.
- that school systems and users are protected from accidental or deliberate misuse that could put the security of the systems and users at risk.
- that parents and carers are aware of the importance of online safety and are involved in the education and guidance of young people with regard to their online behaviour.

The school will try to ensure that students will have good access to technology to enhance their learning and will, in return, expect the students to agree to be responsible users.
