Welcome to Term 6! We hope you all had a May break.

We will be using texts to support our teaching and learning of the Early Years curriculum and this term we have chosen texts to best support the children's knowledge and understanding of our new topic 'Magic.'



We will also be learning the counting rhyme – 10 fat sausages.

This term we will be working on developing skills in all areas of the curriculum. We will be observing seasonal changes without our local environment on our welly walks. We will be looking at artwork by Van Gogh and creating a 'sunflower' picture using shades. We will also be working collaboratively to make a fairy garden out of clay. In preparation for sports day, we will be looking at athletics in PE. We will talk about the past through settings, characters and events encountered in books read in class and storytelling. We will be understanding that people round the world have different religions. We will be exploring computer science, health, well-being, and lifestyle, and much more.

We have begun to learn how to write capital letters and we have sent formation guidance home. Please support your child with practising at home.
